

Pet Friendly Terms & Conditions: PLEASE READ.

Dear Guests,

We are delighted that you and your pet have chosen to stay with us here at the Inn.

As a Pet Friendly hotel, we can only remain this way with the help of good owners who take responsibility for their dogs and are happy to follow our Terms & Conditions:

- Dogs are strictly **NOT** allowed on any furniture in the main Building or Bedrooms. Please do not be offended if asked to remove your dog from our furnishings. If dog hairs are found on sheets, mattresses, sofas etc an extra cleaning charge will be incurred.
- Dogs may **NOT** be left in the Bedroom Unattended at any time, if you are heading for a Meal, this must be booked in our Pet Friendly Area so your furry friend can join you. To dine with your dog, please book a table to avoid disappointment.
- Owners must accompany their pets outside to ensure safety both to their own animals, other animals, and children. Guests are solely responsible for their pets and must clean up after them. Please use the Dog Bin provided outside.
- Dogs may be brought into the Reception Foyer Area providing seating available - If there are already other dogs there you may be asked to wait until later during busy times.
- Dogs are also allowed in the Back Bar/Restaurant so long as they are always kept on a tight lead.
- Retractable leads must be secured so that the dog is not free to wander. Barking or whining dogs may be asked to leave the main building if upsetting other guests.
- Dogs must be washed and have no heavy dog smell - any of the team reserve the right to ask you to take the dog out of the hotel if there is a heavy smell which may put off other customers. Please do not take personal offence but not all our customers are dog lovers, and we must aim to strike a balance.
- If the hotel determines in its sole discretion that the pet is objectionable to other hotel guests, it is the responsibility of the owner to make immediate arrangements to house the pet outside of the hotel.
- The Hotel does not accept liability for any loss, injury, or illness to pets.

You are responsible for any, and all property damage and / or personal injuries resulting from your pet. You must further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Inn on the Coast, its owners and its operators from all liability and damage suffered as a result of your pet. The hotel reserves the right to charge your account an amount, detailed below, per stay to defray cleaning costs, and any additional costs incurred by the hotel to repair any damages caused by your pet. Please check your room on arrival and report if any noticeable pre-existing damage. Your room will be inspected on check out and any new damage charged.
